

ORDINANCE NUMBER 647

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF BASIN, BIG HORN COUNTY, STATE OF WYOMING, ESTABLISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF FENCES WITHIN THE TOWN OF BASIN BY SUPPLEMENTING TITLE EIGHT (8) OF THE BASIN TOWN CODE. ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH ARE HEREBY REPEALED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BASIN, BIG HORN COUNTY, WYOMING:

SECTION 1: Title 8 of the Basin Town Code shall be supplemented by adding the following new Section 8-4-1 et seq., pertaining to the construction of fences, to-wit:

FENCING CODE

8-4-1: **APPLICABILITY:** All fences constructed within the Town of Basin, shall be constructed pursuant to the rules and regulations hereinafter set forth.

8-4-2: **VISIBILITY:** Regardless of other provisions in this section, no fence, wall of hedge shall be erected or maintained in any yard which materially impedes vision of vehicles entering an abutting egress.

8-4-3: **PROHIBITED FENCES:** No fences shall be permitted in any central business zoning district. Barbed wire fencing materials may be used as a portion of a fence in a commercial or industrial zoning district when such material is located not less than eight (8) feet above grade.

8-4-4: **PROHIBITED LOCATION:** No fence, wall or hedge shall be erected or maintained in a public Right-of-way.

8-4-5: **PROHIBITED MATERIALS:** All fences and walls shall be constructed from approved materials and shall not be constructed from railroad ties, rubble, or pallets.
