

ORDINANCE NUMBER 652

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF BASIN, BIG HORN COUNTY, WYOMING, ESTABLISHING NEW ELECTRIC UTILITY RATES FOR OUT-OF-TOWN CUSTOMERS BY SUPPLEMENTING PORTIONS OF SECTION 9-2-1 OF THE BASIN TOWN CODE. ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith ARE HEREBY REPEALED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BASIN, BIG HORN COUNTY, WYOMING:

SECTION 1: The following portions of Section 9-2-1 of the Basin Town Code shall be and are hereby supplemented to read as follows, to-wit (Supplements in **Bold**).

Effective commencing on August 16, 2017, the electrical out-of-town user rates shall be set as follows, to-wit:

9-2-1 G. Non-Residential Service

SECTION 2: If any portion of this ordinance is held or found to be invalid, the remainder of the ordinance shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Town of Basin in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: The purpose for this emergency ordinance is to protect the immediate health and safety concerns of the public by increasing the electric utility service rates for out-of-town user in order to maintain the financial integrity of electric service and to adhere to the policy that out-of-town users should legally pay more for electric service. New electric utility rates for residential, commercial and industrial service for users located within the Town of Basin were increased pursuant to Ordinance 642. The electric utility rates for out-of-town user were inadvertently not increased at the time but should have been. Therefore, it is hereby declared that an emergency exists in that this Ordinance must be in effect immediately with the new rates to commence on **August 16, 2017**. The Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, and shall be published as required by law within a reasonable time thereafter.

SECTION 5: The rule requiring ordinance, except emergency ordinances, to have public readings on three (3) different days unless three-fourths (¾) of the Governing Body vote to suspend the rules as provided by Wyoming Statutes Section 15-1-115, is hereby suspended for the purpose of permitting the adoption of this Ordinance at this meeting.

SECTION 6: In signing this Ordinance, the Mayor proclaims that this Ordinance, adopted and approved this 10th day of **August, 2017**, operates for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and shall become effective immediately upon the date of this proclamation and that this Ordinance shall be published as required by law.

PASSED, APPROVED AND ADOPTED BY THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF THREE-FOURTH (3/4) OF THE QUALIFIED MEMBERS OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF BASIN ON THE FIRST READING ON AUGUST 10, 2017.
