

ORDINANCE NUMBER 653

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF BASIN, BIG HORN COUNTY, STATE OF WYOMING, AMENDING THE RULES FOR FEES AND COSTS FOR MUNICIPAL COURT BY AMENDING SECTION 1-8-3(AA)(2) OF THE BASIN TOWN CODE. ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith ARE HEREBY REPEALED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BASIN, BIG HORN COUNTY, WYOMING:

SECTION 1: Section 1-8-3(AA)(2) of the Basin Town Code shall be amended to read as follows, to-wit:

AA. Costs:

2. Costs and fees assessed and collected in the Basin Municipal Court shall be fixed by the Town of Basin, but shall not exceed the sum of ten dollars (\$10.00), which shall be remitted to the town treasurer. The Court shall assess a Court Automation Fee in the amount of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) as a cost to be paid by every person guilty of a violation of a Town of Basin ordinance or Wyoming State Statute. Said fee shall be remitted to the judicial systems automation account established by Wyoming Statutes Section 5-2-120.

SECTION 2: If any portion of this ordinance is held or found to be invalid, the remainder of the ordinance shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Town of Basin in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect on **DECEMBER 1, 2017**, after having been published in the Basin Republican Rustler.
