August 21, 2018 - Primary Election Day

August 6, 2018 is the last day to register before the Primary Election. Election day registration is available at the polls. Identification is required to register to vote.

If you require assistance at the polls to vote by reason of sight impairment, disability, or inability to read or write, a person of your choice may give you assistance. If you have questions regarding the accessibility of your polling place, please contact Lori Smallwood, County Clerk.

CANDIDATE AND/OR COMMITTEE TO FILE STATEMENT

All candidates, except Precinct Committeemen and Committeewomen, in the Primary Election, whether successful or not, are required by law, to complete a "Statement of Contributions" report. The completed report must be returned to the County Clerk's Office no later than August 14, 2018.

All candidates, except Precinct Committeemen and Committeewomen, in the Primary Election, whether successful or not, are required by law, to complete a "Statement of Contributions and Expenditures" report. The completed report must be returned to the County Clerk's Office no later than August 31, 2018.

All candidates must return each report, regardless if they have contributions and/or expenditures or not. If the candidate has no contributions and/or expenditures, they need to complete the candidate and office information on the first page, of each report, and checkmark the box next to no contributions and/or expenditures statement and send that page, from both reports, to the County Clerk's Office. Be sure to sign each report!

Both the candidate and the candidate committee use the same form to file the "Contributions Report" and the "Contributions and Expenditures Report". If the candidate does not have a committee, only the candidate signs the signature page. If there is a committee, all three signatures meet the requirement of the candidate and the committee both filing.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS FOR THE PRIMARY ELECTION

Absentee Ballots for the Primary Election may be requested at the Big Horn County Clerk's Office. The ballots will be available beginning July 6, 2018. A qualified elector may apply for an absentee ballot either in person, in writing, by email or by phone. The absentee ballot will be mailed to the address given to the Clerk's Office, or the ballot can be picked up at the Clerk's Office.

The names of candidates will be rotated on the official ballots, starting with the first district established by the County Commissioners with the rest following in sequence. Therefore, the candidates will not always appear in the order shown on the sample ballots.
