Call to Order Regular Session

Pledge of Allegiance

A Regular Meeting of the Town of Basin Council was held at Town Hall in Basin, Wyoming on Thursday, May 26, 2022 at 7:00 PM. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM.

Council Members Present: Mayor Duncan, Councilman Godfrey, Councilman Olson, Councilman DesRosier, and Councilman Keele.

Also present were Clerk/Treasurer Deaun Tigner, Chief Kyle McClure, Town Engineer Jesse Frisbee, Barbara Greene, Casey Corey, and Tammy Keele.

Public Comment: None at this time.

Building/Demolition Permits: Tammy Keele (518 W G St): Storage shed. Councilman DesRosier made a motion to approve the building permit for Tammy Keele, Councilman Olson seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

Chicken Application/Permits: None at this time.

Executive Session: None at this time.

Approve Consent Agenda/Additions/Deletions: Councilman Godfrey made a motion to approve the agenda, Councilman DesRosier seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

Conduct of Business:

Planned Power Outage: There is a planned power outage on June 7 from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 a.m.

Basin Community Complex: The Council had a brief discussion on the cost of insurance for the Basin Community Complex.

Eagles: Mayor Duncan reported on the Eagles area. We are making some progress with some adjustments that had to be made already because of the existing concrete walls that were there so the building will be about a foot bigger, moving the existing wall out a bit so we are not building on part of an existing wall. Councilman Olson made a motion to approve the change order, Councilman DesRosier seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

E Street Paving: Town Engineer Jesse Frisbee got all the paperwork in and had scheduled a preconstruction meeting and notice to proceed on Monday, June 6, 2022.

Sewer Project: Town Engineer Jesse Frisbee stated they had just started today doing cleanup. They are anticipating to be done with everything by June 22, 2022. Mayor Duncan asked about Antelope Creek drain that has been overflowing on Big Horn Avenue. The Council had no issue with running the camera underground and making sure it wasn't from the sewer project. Jesse will discuss this with Wilson Bros and if it is an issue from the construction that caused it then we will have Wilson Bros deal with it.

Budget 2022-2023 Review: The Council discussed the budget and the insurance costs for the gym. During the budget review, Mayor Duncan stated he would like to start the conversation on a 6th cent sales tax to run and operate community complex.

Public Comment: No public comment.

Executive Session: Councilman Godfrey made a motion to move out of the regular meeting and into executive session for personnel at 7:25 p.m., Councilman DesRosier seconded, and the motion passed unanimously. Councilman Keele made a motion to go out of executive session and into regular session at 7:44 p.m., Councilman DesRosier seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

There being no further business to discuss, Councilman Godfrey moved to adjourn the regular meeting, Councilman Olson seconded, the motion passed unanimously, and the Regular Meeting was adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
