The Special Meeting was called to order at 6:40 PM. Carl Olson moved and Brent seconded the motion to open the Special Meeting to public comment.

Teri Thon stated that the purpose of the Special Meeting was to hold a public hearing for public comment on the completion of the **upgrading the Town of Basin Office to ADA standards with a handicapped accessible bathroom and automatic front door at 209 South 4th Street.** This project was sponsored by the Wyoming Business Council through the Community Development Block Grant program [funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD)]

According to 24CRF 570.486, a second public hearing must be held after the completion of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) to gather input on the project and to gain an understanding if there are any issues or concerns regarding the project that remain to be addressed.
